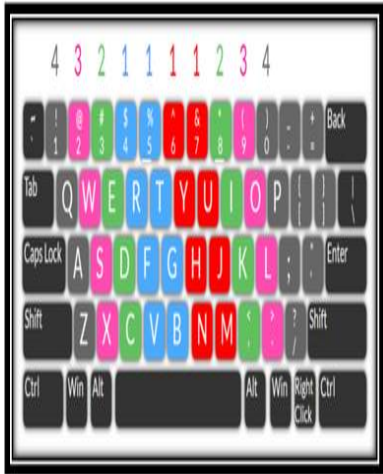
At Gitanjali International School we lay due emphasis on different activities through active participation in various social, athletic and artistic clubs and societies.

Every year, Kargil Vijay Diwas is observed on July 26 to commemorate the success of Operation Vijay in 1999. Kargil Vijay Diwas is celebrated in honour of the Kargil War heroes. The Kargil conflict was fought for more than two months during May-July (1999) in the Kargil District of Jammu and Kashmir along with the Line of Control (LoC). It was named after 'Operation Vijay' (which was launched by India to flush out the Pakistani intruders) in Kargil. On 26, 1999, India successfully took command of all the high outposts and regained control of all the previously held territories.

The importance of the Kargil Diwas is shared by class teachers in GSS Class Assemblies.

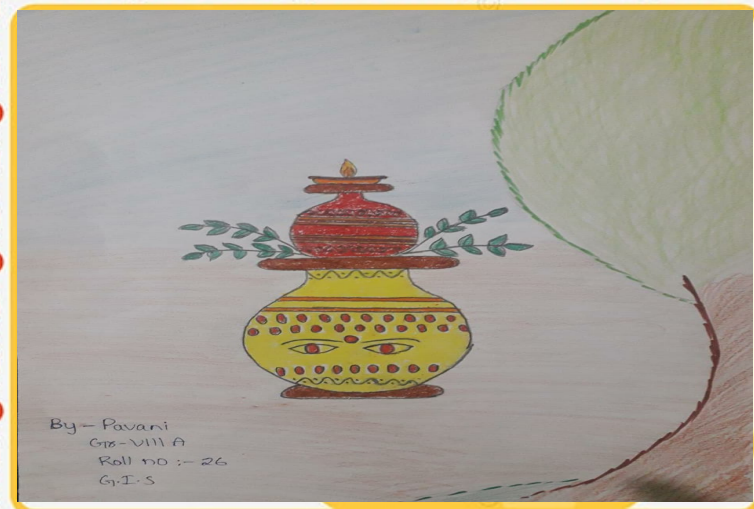
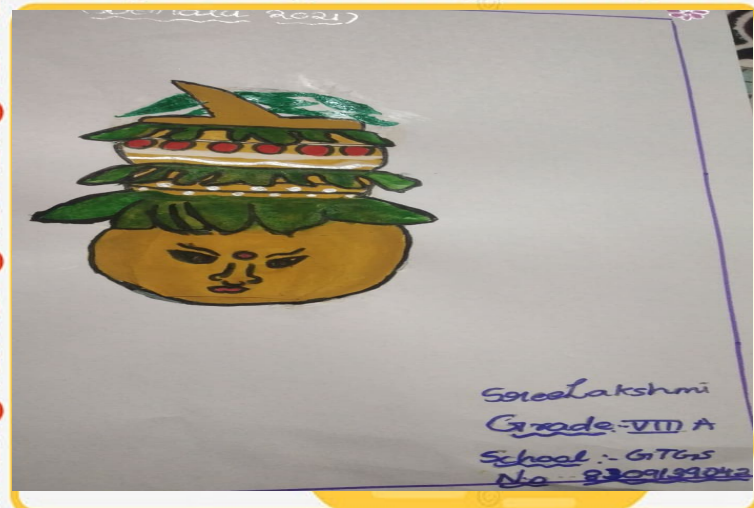


BONALU CELEBRATION

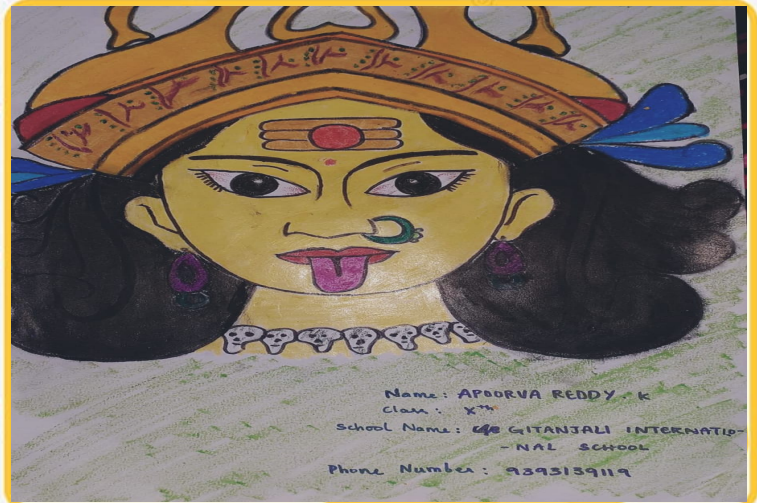

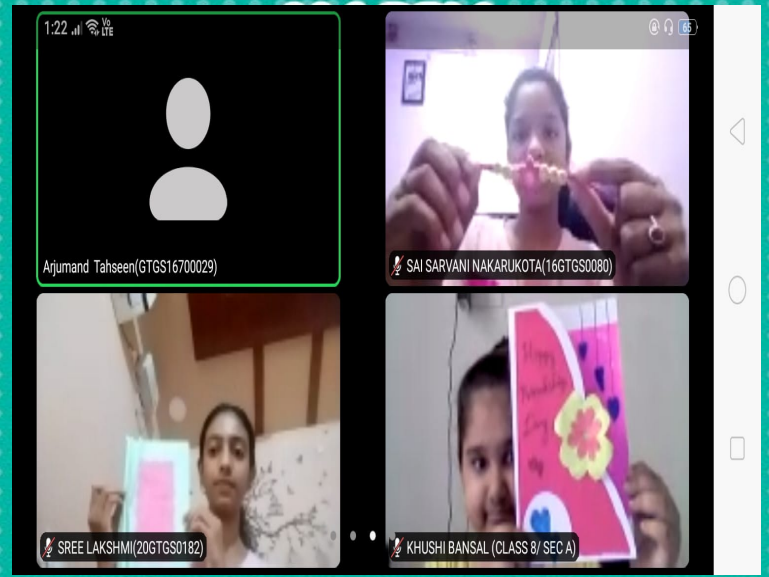
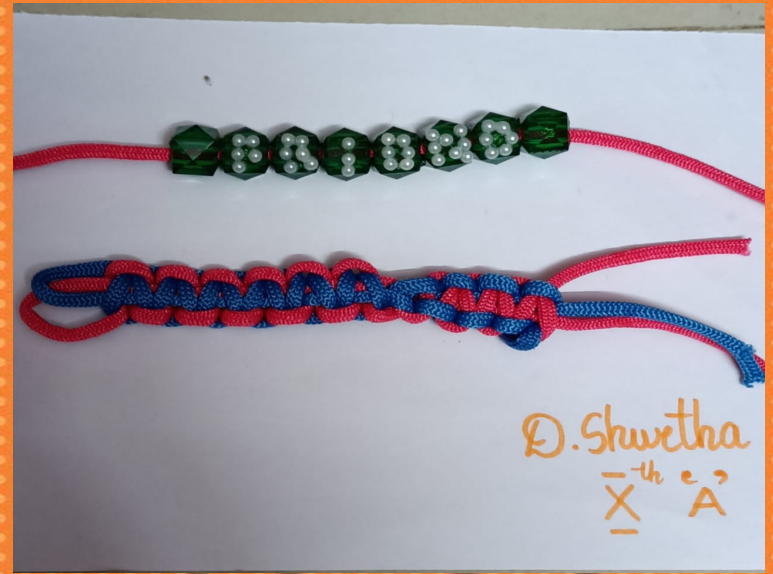
